

and his wife were sitting on the outside deck which is on the second story of their home on the southwest side. He was facing southwest which gives him a view over Tiana Bay to Dune Road and beyond. He saw two red streaks, very vivid in color, ascend from what appeared to be Dune Road and traveled straight, slightly west to east. He guessed it was two miles away. He brought it to the attention of his wife, who turned and saw one streak go west to east straight across the horizon just above the dune line. They did not follow the streak all the way up, as they assumed it was fireworks. The streaks he saw were side by side and very close, and he does wear glasses. then heard what she thought was thunder, followed by a second rumbling which she described as a Concord jet, followed by a very loud thump which they felt. She knew something was not right and looked at her watch, which read 8:30 PM. placed the origin of the streak(s) in a line from his home southwest. Just to the east side of Pine Neck Point. light out and the sun had fallen behind a tree line to the west.
